Just a reminder that we have our session for parents on Tuesday 3rd October at 3.30pm. This will be a session split for Infants and Juniors. If your child is in Infants, you will learn more about how to support your child with phonics and reading at home. If your child is in Juniors, then you will look at ways to support your child with times tables, reading and spelling. If you have a child in each class, parents should start with the Infant session, which will be in the hall and then move to the Juniors where Mr Goddard will go through a second session for those parents. It should last around 30-40 minutes in total.
